



The Retreat Committee of Friendship Quilters Guild, Inc. has organized a 2025 spring quilting retreat at the Procter Center in London OH, Monday, March 31st through Wednesday, April 2nd. London is about 40 miles SW of Dublin in a beautiful country setting, away from the noise and congestion of busier areas. When you need a break from your sewing machine, take a stroll around the grounds or sit in a rocker watching the world go by as you bind a quilt or hand sew.

The first meal is dinner on Monday, March 31st. You're welcome to come as early as 10:00 am and begin to sew. To not go hungry, you'll want to bring lunch. Totally optional is to bring a sweet or salty snack to share with others. It's not necessary as there's always plenty to eat at mealtimes. The last meal is lunch on Wednesday, April 2nd. You can keep sewing until 4:00 pm.

Rooms are decorated with handmade quilts which should make everyone feel welcome. Some of the quilts used in the rooms, as well as some used to decorate other places, were made by our guild members. Relax, chat, laugh, eat, and sew while getting to know fellow guild members. A table, chair, power strip, and wastebasket are provided to each person attending the retreat.

Each person must register separately online.

Payment must be made at the time of registration.

The deadline to register is Monday, March 17, 2025, by noon.
